Migrations revealed in land records:

1. The late Mary Owens Steinmetz combed the court records for Berks County and compiled out-of-state references found in these records. These entries document migrations of the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries and also establish a number of family relationships. Her notes were deposited in the collection of the Genealogical Society of Pennsylvania. Several articles utilizing this data have been published in their *Pennsylvania Genealogical Magazine*, in various issues. Entries for Maryland are in Vol. 23(1963), pgs. 15-22; entries for Virginia are in Vol. 23(1964), pgs.251-261, and Vol. 29(1975) pgs. 68-71. [R-Gen 974.8005 PEN]
