Access these records:

- US Census (1790-1930, see comparison chart on the reverse side for years indexed. All images are available.)
- Books (Over 20,000 Family and Local Histories)
- Freedman’s Bureau (Search for individuals in Freedman’s Bank, 1865-1874, for the benefit of freed slaves.)
- PERSI (Periodical Source Index, is an index of over 1.6 million genealogy and local history articles)
- Revolutionary War Pension and Bounty-Land Warrant Application Files (Series M805 - Search selected records.)
- United States Congressional Serial Set (15<sup>th</sup> Congress, 1<sup>st</sup> Session 1817) Includes American State Papers. The whole collection: 1789-1969

Following are step-by-step directions:
