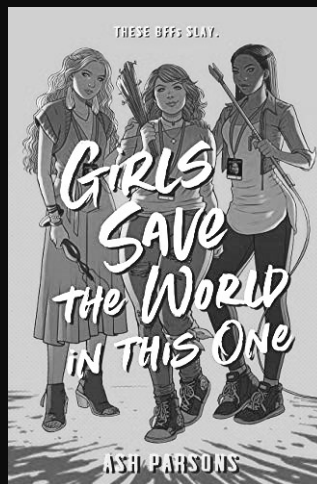

TEEN SUMMER READING 2020

MATERIALS:

Bubble solution with wand

Food Coloring

Journal

What you will need:

Paper or a garbage bag to cover your workspace.

Shallow bowls or cups

Tablespoon

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Pour 1 tablespoon of the bubble mix into a small, shallow bowl.

2. Add a few drops of food coloring to the bubble mix and stir well.

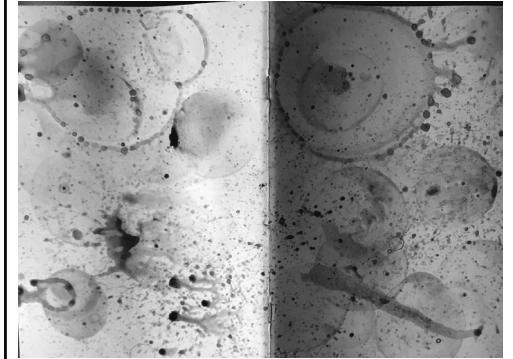


3. Place your bubble wand in the colored bubble mix, remove, and blow bubbles towards your paper.

ALTERNATIVE ACTIVITY:

Try placing the bubbles in a cup with some food coloring or craft paints. Using a straw, blow bubbles in the cup until they reach the top. Place your paper over the top of the cup to form different patterns.

As the bubbles hit the paper and pop, they will leave interesting patterns. Repeat with other colors. Don't be afraid to be creative and mix colors!



4. Let dry before moving or closing the book.

Tips:

Stay close to your paper when blowing the bubbles. For the best result, blow the bubble straight down onto the paper.

Caution: Food coloring will stain surfaces and clothing. Be sure to protect both!

This activity can be frustrating on a windy day - as the wind makes it hard to get the bubbles to hit the paper!
