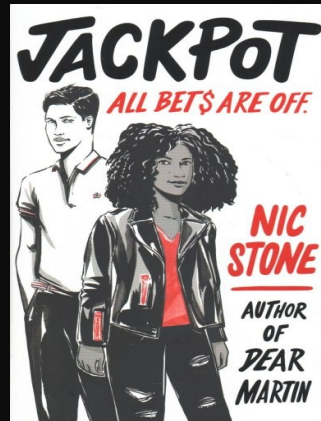

Friendship Bracelets



TEEN SUMMER READING 2020

MATERIALS:

4 colors of embroidery thread, each 30 inches long.

What you will need:

Tape or a safety pin
A bit of patience

INSTRUCTIONS (from Klutz)

Tape the top of your thread to a hard surface (or pin it to a pillow using a safety pin)

Start with string **1** and loop it over and then under string **2**. Hold string **2** straight (this is important) and pull the knot snug.



Tip #1: If you are struggling, it may help to think of making the number 4.

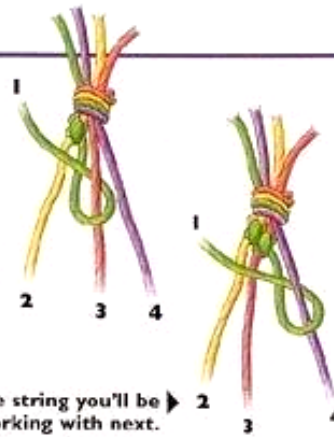

Do step **1** a second time so you have a double knot.

Now take string **1** and make double knots around each of the remaining strands (**3** and **4**), left



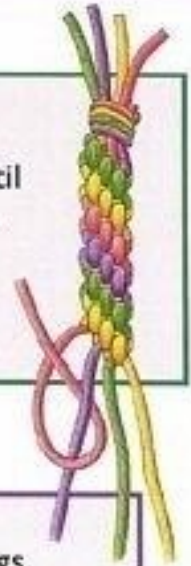

Now do the same thing again. Start with the far left strand **2** and tie double knots, left to right, all the way across the other colors.

Keep going until the bracelet is as long as you would like.

Gather the strings and tie a knot to secure. Trim the ends to about 1 inch.

This is a basic pattern, but there are so many others!
