

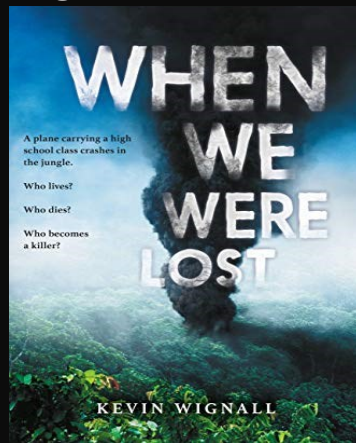

DIY SQUISHIES!



TEEN SUMMER READING 2020

MATERIALS:

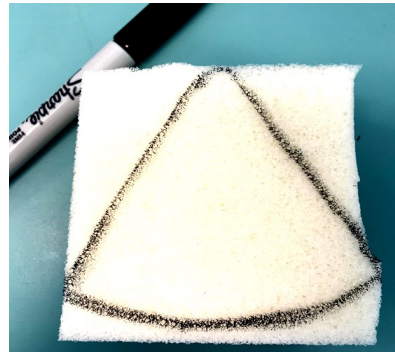
Memory Foam
Acrylic paint and paintbrushes

What you will need:

Scissors
Sharpie or other marker

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using a sharpie or other marker, draw your design on the memory foam.



2. Using sharp scissors, cut out the rough shape of your design. Next, use the scissors to snip and trim tiny amounts off the foam until the shape is smooth around the edges and you are happy with the design.



Note: It's best to use smaller cuts so you don't accidentally cut away too much of the foam. You can always cut more away if needed.

3. Time to paint! Using your paint brush or a craft stick, paint your squishy. Use small amounts of paint and blend it well into the foam. Using only a light layer of paint helps your squishy maintain its slow-rising squishiness!



4. Let dry for 24 hours before squishing or playing with them.
